We are inviting all of our younger members to participate in the Call for Poster Boards. The boards will be judged based on the overall information presented for projects that are unique, interesting, innovative, or challenging. The winners will ultimately have their poster boards displayed at our Annual Convention.

The Younger Engineers Award Program was founded by a generous donation from Mr. Nabih Youssef to the SEAOCC Convention. The original intent remains: To encourage young engineers to attend the SEAOCC Annual Convention by offering awards to help cover their costs.

ELIGIBILITY: All current members of SEAOCC, age thirty-five (35) years and younger.

AWARDEES: One (1) representative from each regional Member Organization (SEAOCC, SEAOCS, SEAOCC, and SEAOCD), and up to five (5) at-large representatives, nine (9) total.

AWARD: Winners will be awarded full registration, granting them access to *All Technical & Business Sessions; Trade Show; Continental Breakfasts; Breaks; Lunches; Welcome Reception; Area 51 Experience (Thursday Social); O Show Technical Presentation, O Show Dinner Reception, and O Show Performance*. In addition, winners will be allowed to invite one guest, free of charge, to the Thursday night dinner where their awards will be presented.
